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- This journal adheres to a single-anonymized peer-review policy. The title page should be included in the main document.
- The title page should list the article title and each author's full name, degree, title, department, affiliation (mailing address), and e-mail address. If available, please provide each author's ORCID. Indicate the corresponding author.

Abstract and Keywords

See the section Article Types for word limits.

The abstract should briefly outline the content of the article and any conclusions it may reach. The keywords should be words a reader would be likely to use in searching for the content of the article.

Requirements for Original Research Articles

- 1. **Structured Abstract-** The submission should include a structured abstract with the following headings of no more than 150 words.
 - a. **Introduction** (nature of the problem and its significance)
 - b. **Objectives & Hypotheses** (specific objectives of the study, including primary and secondary outcomes)
 - Study Design (Meta-analysis, systematic review, randomized clinical trial, prospective or retrospective cohort study, case-control series or case series (N>5)). State appropriate reporting guidelines: PRISMA (systematic reviews and meta-analyses), CONSORT (randomized trials) and STROBE (observational studies).
 - d. **Methods** (Patient selection criteria, interventions, data collection and measurements, statistical analyses performed; include any IRB approval or AI use in Manuscript Preparation)
 - e. **Results** (Include results and statistical analysis related to primary and secondary endpoints)
 - f. **Conclusions** (Describe the main findings, mechanisms, and explanations, how they relate to prior knowledge and the relevance of these)
